## the course

Make your own film from start to finish in 10 days! We'll cover everything from research to distribution. All films focus on a social or environmental theme to raise awareness about pressing issues, like conservation of natural resources, climate change, sustainable livelihoods, traditional culture, agriculture, and so much more. You'll learn how to find your story and get the shots you need, while refining your creative and artistic vision to reach your target audience. Learn how to integrate photography, music, effects, and social media marketing to maximize the impact of your film. Learn how to create a film that can be used for multiple purposes, like education, advocacy, and fundraising. Learn valuable skills in researching, interviewing, editing, and the ethics and best practices for filmmaking in different social, cultural, and physical environments. And, gain valuable experience for your future career! Most of all, learn about your passion and your voice as a filmmaker and how you can be an agent of change.

### the location

Our first session is in Ubud, **Bali**, an area rich in social and environmental stories. Students will be immersed in Bali's cultural centre, surrounded by a landscape of lush rice fields and traditional artisan villages, which contrast with the rapid development, tourism, and outside influence the small town is experiencing. We will be intimately connected to both nature and the city, and the local changemakers working on various social and environmental issues there. Our field trips will take us deeper into Bali's unique cultural and physical landscapes.
